Bina Fernandez is Associate Professor in Development Studies at the University of Melbourne, Australia.

She completed her PhD and MPhil degrees at the University of Oxford, and previously taught at the University of Leeds, the Institute of Development Studies, Sussex, and the University of Oxford in the UK.

Her research illuminates how a feminist analysis of social reproduction is critical to the understanding of poor and ethnic minority women's precarious access to economic resources in India, and consequently to the construction of policy interventions to improve their access to and control over such resources.
