Recent books include *Worker Identity, Agency and Economic Development: Womens empowerment in the Indian informal economy*, Routledge (2010) and *Women, work and Care in the Asia Pacific*, Routledge (2017). Her next book, *Employment Policy in Emerging Economies: The Indian Case* is an edited volume with Amitendu Palit and will be published by Routledge in late 2017.

Elizabeth is affiliated with the Delhi School of Economics and the Tata Institute of Social Sciences, Mumbai. Elizabeth is currently Chair of the Department of Political Economy and Chair of the Indian advisory Group at The University of Sydney.
