Dr Kuntala Lahiri-Dutt is a Senior Fellow of the Resource, Environment and Development group at ANU's Crawford School of Public Policy. Kuntala researches precarious livelihoods in environmental resource-dependent communities.

Her extensive research on India has made her a global authority on the gendered labour in the mines and quarries. Kuntala's books include *The Coal Nation: Histories, Politics and Ecologies of Coal in India*; *Dancing with the River: People and Lives on the Chars in South Asia*; *Gendering the Field: Towards Sustainable Livelihoods for Mining Communities*; *Women Miners in Developing Countries: Pit Women and Others*.

Besides these primary areas of research, Kuntala pursues an interest in marginal communities and how rural migrants, moving into cities in South Asia reconnect with their roots.
