He has researched shared governance arrangements between government conservation agencies and Indigenous communities in national parks and World Heritage Areas, including direct contributions to policy development.

Other research examines Indigenous and local knowledge systems and how these interact with Western knowledge frameworks, as well as the cultural dimensions of hunting, especially around knowledge, respect and sacredness. He has worked with Indigenous and other communities in India, across Australia, in Arctic Scandinavia, Indonesia, and the USA.
