Professor David Lowe holds a Chair in Contemporary History at Deakin University.

He is a biographer and historian of modern international affairs, especially with reference to Australia's role in the Asia and the Pacific.

He is a co-founder of the Australian Policy and History network, elected Board Member of the journal, Australian Historical Studies, and a member of the Australian Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade Editorial Advisory Board, advising the Australian Foreign Minister with respect to the Documents on Australian Foreign Policy Series.

He has been Director and a commissioned lecturer for the Master of Strategic Studies offered to senior Australian and international military personnel and public servants at the Centre for Defence and Strategic Studies in Canberra. In 2015 he was elected a Fellow of the Academy of Social Sciences in Australia.
