Tanya Jakimow is an Associate Professor of Anthropology and Future Fellow in the College of Asia and the Pacific, The Australian National University.

Tanya's current research has three foci: a comparative ethnography of the labour of women political actors in Dehradun, India and Medan, Indonesia, funded by an ARC Future Fellowship; an international collaboration examining women's non-elite pathways to politics in Indonesia and Sri Lanka, funded by the Development Leadership Program, and; a collaborative ethnography of Mahindra World City, a so-called 'city from scratch' in Tamil Nadu, funded by an ARC Discovery grant.

Her theoretical concerns as outlined in her recent monograph *Susceptibility in Development: the micro-politics of urban development in India and Indonesia*, (July 2020, Oxford University Press) include the intersection of affect and emotions, power, personhood, and the ways these shape 'development'.
