Tim Scrase (PhD, LaTrobe, 1989) was formerly an Adjunct Professor in the School of Global, Urban and Social Studies at RMIT University (Melbourne) (2017-2020); an Associate Dean for Research and Professor of Sociology in the Faculty of Education and Arts at the Australian Catholic University (2010-2017); and for several years prior he was the Director of the ARC Key Centre for Asia Pacific Social Transformation Studies (CAPSTRANS) at the University of Wollongong.

He has been a regular visiting research fellow at the International Institute for Asian Studies (IIAS), University of Amsterdam. He has previously been awarded three Australia Research Council (ARC) grants and is a past President of the South Asian Studies Association of Australia (SAASA).

Over a 35 year career he has published widely on development and social change in India in leading academic journals and edited collections, including five books. Based on a recent ARC-funded project, he is currently preparing a manuscript on the urban transformation of Darjeeling.
